

The early church carried this tradition on when they, "devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and prayer." Acts 2:42. Consider joining a small group as a Leader/Facilitator, Host, Participant, or Ambassador. A leader facilitates the study and discussion . . .

**Leader/Facilitator** ~ will be trained and are not expected to have all answers to every question. **Host** ~ open their home and provides hospitality and refreshments. (The Leader may also serve as Host) **Participant** ~ join and regularly attend small group. **Ambassador** ~ represent small group ministry in the congregation and community.

Denis Agosta is one individual who stepped out in faith to serve as a small group leader, and his wife, Val, is the host. Having never facilitated a small group before, Denis shared, "Just push past the fear and do it. When you lead or teach, you are the invariably the one who ends up learning. You don't have to be a Bible expert, believe me, I'm not; but we all end up learning together."

TIP#1: Kohl's scrip cards (Both physical and e-gift cards) can be used to pay on your Kohl's Credit Card
